Affordable Housing	Housing Rehabilitation Program (CDBG)	Provide housing rehabilitation assistance to income-eligible homeowners in the Kane County Com. Dev. Program Area. (Funding amount includes \$20,000 in anticipated program income.)	\$306,526
Infrastructure	Pasadena Drive Area Flood Control	Complete final engineering and design for storm sewer improvements and an overland flood route to convey floodwaters away from a residential subdivision in Aurora Township.	\$13,000
	South Park/Mastadon Lake Drainage Improvements	Complete preliminary and final engineering, a flood-damage analysis, and feasibility analysis for a residential area in both the City of Aurora and unincorporated Aurora Township.	\$30,000
	Hickory/Ash Infrastructure	Reconstruct sanitary sewers, water mains, water services, storm sewers, carriage walk, and roadway, and install new street lights along Hickory Drive, Hickory Court, and Ash Street in the Village of Carpentersville.	\$149,952
	Hazard/Monroe/Golfview Infrastructure	Reconstruct sanitary sewers, water mains, water services, carriage walk, sidewalk, and roadway, construct new storm sewers, widen turn lanes, and install new street lights and traffic signals along Hazard Road, Monroe Avenue, and Golfview Lane in the Village of Carpentersville.	\$263,478
	Monroe Street Reconstruction	Reconstruct Monroe Street in the Village of North Aurora from State Street (Route 56) to the northern terminus, and construct a sidewalk on the east side of the street.	\$19,450
Public Facilities	Kane County Floodplain Buyout	Purchase, clear, and restore property in unincorporated Dundee Township under FEMA's Repetitive Flood Loss Mitigation Program.	\$66,181
Homelessness	Continuum of Care Administration	Provide administrative support for the Continuum of Care for Kane County, which coordinates services for the homeless.	\$8,000
	Lazarus House	Provide operating support for emergency homeless shelter and transitional housing program that serves central Kane County.	\$58,000
	PADS (Aurora)	Provide operating support for emergency homeless shelter that serves southern Kane County.	\$46,000
	PADS of Elgin	Provide operating support for emergency homeless shelter that serves northern Kane County.	\$40,000
Planning and Capacity-Building	Administration and Planning	Provide funds to cover expenses associated with administration of the Community Development Program, as well as certain planning activities. (Funding amount includes \$13,000 in prior year funds.)	\$243,000
