



DO YOU NEED A RIDE TO WORK?

If you live in Kane County, you may be eligible for work-related assistance through the County's **Ride in Kane (RIK) program!** RIK is a 24/7 transportation service that provides rides within the County to qualifying residents who are low-income, age 65 and older, or have disabilities. Rides are provided by small buses or a taxi service and cost \$5 one way, with an additional \$1.50 charge for each mile over 10 miles.

How to Register for Rides

RIK is administered by the Kane County Division of Transportation in partnership with Pace Suburban Bus. Local municipalities, townships, and social service agencies operate as local sponsors that provide funding for their residents. **You must register as a RIK user before you can schedule rides.**

1 Check out the map on the back of this flyer to see if you live in a sponsored County area. If you do live in a sponsored area, please visit the RIK website's sponsor page for registration contact information at <http://kdot.countyofkane.org/RIK/Pages/sponsors.aspx>. If you're unsure about your sponsor, please contact Kane County at (630) 762-2600 for assistance.

2 Your RIK sponsor will assist you through their registration process. You will likely need to provide a government-issued ID for residency verification, as well as proof of monthly or annual income. The sponsor will tell you what income-related documents satisfy proof of income. For the RIK program, "low-income" is defined as an individual whose family income is at or below 150% of the federal poverty guidelines.

3 Once you're successfully registered, you will receive a RIK Rider's Guide with program information and instructions on how to schedule your work ride.



2023 RIDER INCOME THRESHOLDS

To qualify for RIK work-related assistance, your family income cannot exceed 150% of the 2023 Federal Poverty Guidelines based on the number of individuals in your household.

For families/households with more than 8 persons, add \$5,140 for each additional person.

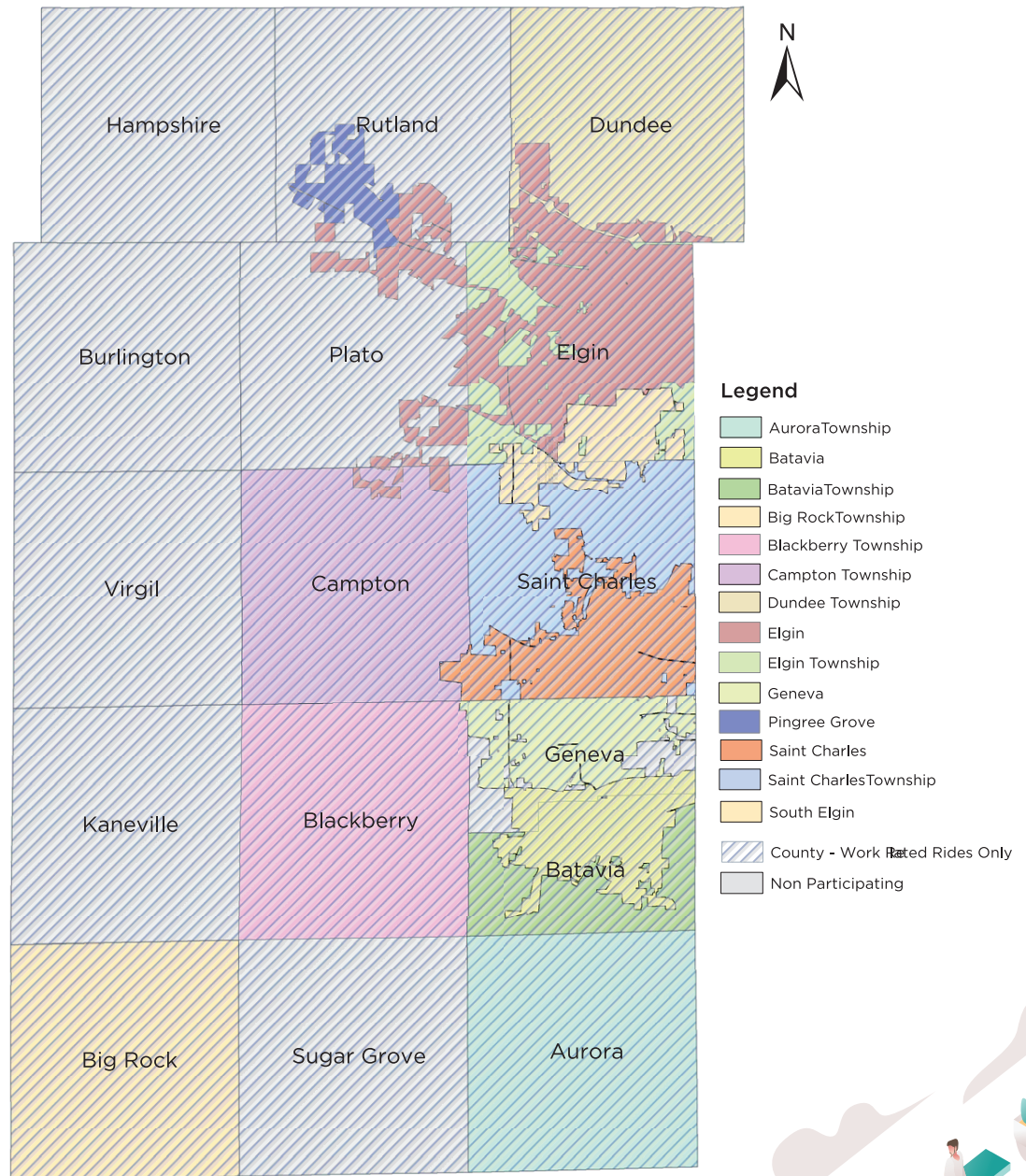
