RESOLUTION NO.

RESTATING ACTIVITIES RELATED TO EMPLOYEE WELLNESS PROGRAM

WHEREAS, since 2008 Kane County has engaged in multiple measures to control the costs of providing healthcare to employees and their spouses who are enrolled in Kane County-sponsored health plans; and

WHEREAS, one of those measures resulted in the establishment of the Employee Wellness Program; and

WHEREAS, the Employee Wellness Program is voluntary and consists of a health risk assessment and finger stick blood draw for biometric screening. If an enrolled employee participates in the program, the employee's healthcare contribution rate will be reduced by \$50 per month. If an enrolled spouse participates in the program, the employee's healthcare contribution rate shall not exceed \$100 per month based upon both the participation of the employee and the employee's spouse; and

WHEREAS, if an enrolled employee and the employee's spouse decline to participate in the program, the employee will pay a healthcare contribution rate based upon the lack of participation; and

WHEREAS, the Human Resources Department with oversight from the Human Services Committee is authorized to create procedures to implement the wellness program and to conduct activities in furtherance of the wellness program, including procedures for adjusting the employee contribution deduction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this authorizes the restatement of Resolution 16 - 140. Human Resources Department is authorized to work with the consultants of Gallagher Benefit Services to plan and conduct the Introductory Wellness Package so that Kane County can qualify for rebates available through the Intergovernmental Personnel Benefit Cooperative's Wellness Program.
