The Resolution provides support for the development of the Wisconsin-Illinois Fox River Water Trail Initiative and subsequent application for designation by the National Park Service.

RESOLUTION NO.

AUTHORIZING KANE COUNTY SUPPORT FOR THE WISCONSIN-ILLINOIS FOX RIVER WATER TRAIL INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, the Fox River is recognized as a major natural resource corridor with potential for recreation, scenic and historic trails and for economic development of river communities; and

WHEREAS, the National Water Trails system is a collaborative effort administered by the National Park Service; and

WHEREAS, Kane County enjoys the beautiful and scenic Fox River as part of their communities and as a clean, drinkable water source; and

WHEREAS, Kane County has an outstanding forest preserve system and is engaged in development of river access and diverse recreational opportunities along the Fox River to serve the needs of residents and visitors alike; and

WHEREAS, Kane County encourages and supports efforts to enhance economic development along the riverfront and revitalization of river communities; and

WHEREAS, the Kane County 2040 Plan promotes the enhancement and expansion of the County's green infrastructure network providing functional connections between water resources, natural areas, forest preserves, cultural and historic sites, and communities as part of the region's Green Infrastructure Vision; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Wisconsin-Illinois Fox River Water Trail Initiative is to establish and interpret a Fox River Water Trail along the 223-mile river course from the headwaters in the Town of Lisbon, Wisconsin, to the confluence with the Illinois River in Ottawa, Illinois to provide access for all to the natural resources, recreational opportunities, scenic beauty, and historic and cultural assets of the Fox River Valley; and

WHEREAS, the objectives of the Wisconsin-Illinois Fox River Water Trail Initiative includes promoting ecotourism and recreational opportunities throughout the River corridor, enhancing community recognition of the unique assets of the Fox River and supporting economic development and revitalization of river communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Kane County hereby supports the Wisconsin-Illinois Fox River Water Trail Initiative seeking designation as a National Water Trail as part of the National Water Trail System.
