

Summary:

"Making Kane County Fit for Kids" is a public-private partnership that grew out of the Community Health Action Plan (IPLAN) adopted by the Kane County Board in December, 2006 that identified "reducing chronic disease" as one of Kane's five health priorities. The partnership was born following a county-wide leadership summit on childhood obesity convened by Chairman McConnaughay in April, 2008.

To support the Fit for Kids effort, Kane County applied for and received one of the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation's *Healthy Kids, Healthy Communities* grants. This four-year \$360,000 grant supports the County's efforts in coordinating "Fit for Kids" and its collaborative efforts to integrate land use, transportation and health planning across county departments, with local governmental entities like municipalities and school districts, and with the private sector.

In February 2010, Kane County hosted a Future Search Conference focused on childhood obesity. This conference was called the *Fit Kids 2020 Leadership Summit*. Over one hundred leaders came together for a day and one-half and held focused conversations about the things that have led to the childhood obesity issue, the present state of the problem and what needs to happen in the future to reverse this trend. As a follow up to this summit, work began on the *Fit Kids 2020 Plan*. Nine sector-specific Fit Kids 2020 workgroups worked to create this written set of policy level strategies and action steps.

This **Fit Kids 2020** plan is the work of over 80 community stakeholders, meeting over the past 6 months, contributing well over 1,000 hours of volunteer time to produce it. Workgroups dedicated their time to researching, meeting and discussing and adopting strategies to change policies, systems and the built environment in Kane county to support active living and healthy eating.

Board action to endorse the plan is the next step in integrating health into the 2040 update of the master land use and transportation plan of Kane county and is following through on one of the recommendations of the **Conceptual Land Use Strategy** adopted by the Board in October, 2010. Board action will facilitate implementation of the Fit Kids strategies by County departments and support similar actions by other organizations across Kane county.

ENDORSING THE 'FIT KIDS 2020 PLAN

WHEREAS, the current Community Health Action Plan developed in 2006 and adopted by the Kane County Board on December 22, 2006 Resolution 06-495 identifies "Reducing chronic disease" as one of Kane County's top health priorities and further recognizes obesity as a major contributor to the burden of chronic disease in Kane; and

WHEREAS, since 2008, the Kane County Board has supported the development and implementation of the "Making Kane County 'Fit for Kids'" initiative, to reverse the epidemic of childhood obesity in Kane County, by accepting a grant for that purpose from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation and by approving allocations of Kane County health funds to the Fit for Kids Fund administered by the Community Foundation of the Fox River Valley; and

WHEREAS, as part of the 'Fit for Kids' initiative, the Kane County Departments of Development and Community Services, Health and Transportation have actively collaborated with each other and with more than eighty (80) community leaders who served in nine (9) working groups representing the complex inter-relationships of issues and constituencies that must act together to reverse childhood obesity; and

WHEREAS, these community leaders developed and have issued **Fit Kids 2020** a strategic plan to reverse the epidemic of childhood obesity in Kane by 2020, with more than fifty (50) sector-specific strategies for adoption by Kane's employers, schools, faith-based organizations and units of local government; and

WHEREAS, the sector-specific strategies in **Fit Kids 2020** are grouped under four (4) strategic action principles of "Making Kane County Fit for Kids", specifically: 1) Develop land use, planning and other public policies that foster and support physical activity for all our communities; 2) Assure that fresh fruits and vegetables are affordable and accessible to all families in our communities; 3) Support a culture of wellness and health promotion in our workplaces, schools, homes, communities and other institutions; and 4) Provide parents and children with reliable, up-to-date information in multiple settings regarding healthy physical activity and eating habits; and

WHEREAS, these same strategic action principles are incorporated into Strategy Recommendation #3 of the 2040 Conceptual Land Use Strategy (page 5 of <u>Then, Now &</u> <u>Tomorrow:</u> <u>2040 Conceptual Land Use Strategy</u>) a report from the Regional Planning Commission to the Kane County Board August 4, 2010 and adopted by the Kane County Board on October 12, 2010 by Resolution 10-297 and with that same resolution directed the Kane County Regional Planning Commission to proceed with the preparation of a draft 2040 Land Resource Management Plan to be presented to the County Board in 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Kane County Board that it hereby endorses the attached **Fit Kids 2020 Plan** and the four (4) "Making Kane County 'Fit for Kids'" strategic action principles that provide the framework for its specific recommendations; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Kane County Departments are directed and encouraged to review the **Fit Kids 2020 Plan** and adopt and implement the recommended strategies that are relevant to the department and its employees, particularly those related to employee wellness and transportation, land use and health policy, systems and practices; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Kane County Board encourages all Kane County families, employers, schools, faith-based organizations and units of local government to review the **Fit Kids 2020 Plan**, adopt the recommended strategies that are relevant to them, and join together to reverse the epidemic of childhood obesity in Kane by 2020.

Following the Blizzard of 2011 the OEM has been working with the Illinois Emergency Management Agency to complete a preliminary damage assessment to identify costs incurred by the County, local municipalities, and certain non-profit organizations. These costs compiled for Kane County, and submitted to Springfield, were included with the Governors request of President Obama for a federal disaster declaration.

When the President grants the declaration the OEM will work with our community partners to insure each are able to submit their eligible costs to FEMA for up to a 75% reimbursement.

During the month of March the OEM has been concentrating on the development of two major exercises that are scheduled for April. The first of these is a multi-jurisdictional EOC functional exercise where two municipal EOCs and the County EOC will work in tandem to respond to a significant tornado touchdown.

The second exercise is a regional emergency shelter activation. This is part of our local development of capabilities in support of the Illinois-Wisconsin-Indiana Regional Catastrophic Planning Initiative.

Following the Homeland Security Exercise and Enhancement Program (HSEEP), there is a significant amount of work to be done for both exercises to ensure they adequately test the capabilities of our plans along with complying with national standards.

Following these exercises an after action report and improvement plan will be developed and submitted to Springfield for review and approval.

Also this month the OEM opened the County emergency operations center up for a group of local boy scouts who are working to complete their emergency preparedness merit badges. Following a tour of the facility a discussion took place as to the work that is done by the OEM to protect our citizens. We also discussed how they could help to prepare their communities along with developing an emergency preparedness plan for their families.




