

## **TRUTH IN TAXATION HEARING – OCTOBER 14, 2003**

The Truth In Taxation hearing of the Kane County Board was held at the Kane County Government Center, Geneva, IL at 10:06 a.m. on Tuesday, October 14, 2003, Michael W. McCoy, Chairman; John A. Cunningham, Clerk.
