

**KANE COUNTY PUBLIC HEARING
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2009**

**Special Services Areas and Provide for the Levy of Taxes for the Purpose of
Paying the Cost of Providing Special Services In and For Such Areas**

Kane County Public Hearing was called to order on Tuesday September 8, 2009 at 9:52 a.m. Present: Chairman, Karen McConnaughay, County Clerk, Cunningham, County Board Members and members of the public and the press.

Public Hearing convened for the purpose of receiving public comment on the proposal to establish Special Services Areas and provide for the levy of taxes for the Purpose of paying the cost of providing special services in and for such areas.

Chairman McConnaughay invited public comment on the special services areas of Middlecreek and Shirewood Farms areas. Jody Wollnik of the Kane County Water Resources Division testified on the background of these projects. She said that both these projects are an approved cost share drainage projects from earlier in 2009. At the present, they have received letters of no objections from all of the citizens in the Middlecreek and Shirewood Farm special service areas. Her department will bring the establishing ordinance to the Development meeting the following week.
