

CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE REQUIRED BY KANE COUNTY

Contractor to furnish and deliver prior to commencement of work, a completed Certificate of Insurance satisfactory to the County of Kane containing:

- a. Provision that coverage cannot be cancelled without thirty-day notice to the County.
- b. Compliance with statutory limits of the State of Illinois for worker's Compensation and Employer's Liability.
- c. The minimum amounts of general liability insurance shall be as follows, except no restriction on occurrence limits will be permitted:

General Liability Limit - \$2,000,000 combined single limit for Bodily Injury and Property Damage per person for each occurrence.
- d. Contractor to have Automobile Liability insurance on any autos, hired autos, and non-owned autos of \$1,000,000.

Contractor to furnish a copy of the Endorsement showing Kane County as an additional named insured on the General Liability policy; or provide separate coverage, in the amounts enumerated above, with an Owner's Protective policy.

The Contractor shall cease operations on the project if the insurance is cancelled or reduced below the required amount of coverage.
