The mission of the Kane County Riverboat Fund Program is to serve as a financial aid for programs strengthening Kane County's communities and government through efforts in education, environment, and economic development and with emphasis on addressing challenges and providing long-term solutions. (In general, projects shall be made for capital purposes only, not for ongoing operating expenses.)

The Kane County Riverboat Fund Program is funded through an agreement between Kane County and the Grand Victoria Foundation, and the actual dollar amount available for the Grant Program varies from year to year.


For the past two years, we have had an Open Enrollment period at the start of the calendar year. In an effort to coordinate the Riverboat Fund Program and the Community Development Fund Program, this year's Open Enrollment period will begin November 5, 2007 and conclude the first Friday in January, 2008 (January 4, 2008).
