On behalf of Governor Pat Quinn and the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity ("DCEO"), I am pleased to inform you that Kane County's application for Illinois IKE Disaster Recovery Public Infrastructure Program ("IKE-PI") grant funding has been approved in the amount of \$298,747 for a Drainage project.
