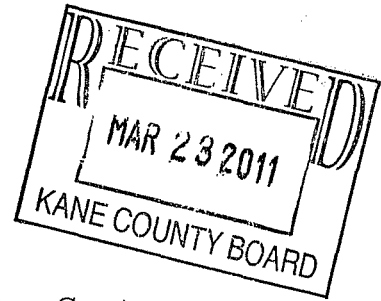


This contract for professional services is by and between the Regional Office of Education, hereafter referred to as the Contractor, and Kane County Court Services, hereafter referred to as the Purchaser.

1. SERVICES RENDERED – The Contractor agrees to provide the professional services of a Coordinator for the Juvenile Drug Court Program. The Coordinator will provide case management services, including appropriate referral and monitoring of drug treatment services, to those juveniles involved in Juvenile Drug Court.
2. PAYMENT FOR SERVICES – The Contractor shall receive the sum of \$54,699, to be used solely for the salary, benefits, and mileage associated with the Coordinator position.
3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This contract shall become effective 12/1/10 and shall terminate 11/30/11.
4. TERMINATION - Each party reserves the right to terminate this contract at any time with two (2) weeks written notice to the other party. In the event of default or non-compliance with the terms of this Contract, it may be terminated immediately. Such termination shall be given in writing on the day of said occurrence. In the event of termination, the Contractor will be paid for services rendered to the date of termination.
5. NON-DISCRIMINATION – The Contractor agrees to comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Constitution of the United States, and the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois and any laws, regulations or orders, State or Federal, which prohibit discrimination on the grounds of race, sex, religion, national origin, or inability to speak or comprehend the English language.
6. CONFIDENTIALITY – The Contractor agrees that any information obtained concerning persons served by the Juvenile Drug Court Program shall remain confidential as to third parties, but shall be provided upon request to the Purchaser. The Contractor agrees not to disclose any information concerning

said persons without prior approval of the Individual and parent or guardian and the Purchaser.

7. LIABILITY – The Purchaser assumes no liability for actions of the Contractor under this contract. The Contractor agrees to hold harmless the Purchaser against any and all liability loss, damage, cost, or expense arising from wrongful or negligent acts of Contractor which the Purchaser may sustain, incur, or be required to pay as a result of Contractor’s performance under this Contract.

8. MONITORING AND EVALUATIONS – The Contractor agrees to maintain any records required by the Purchaser and in accordance with any state or federal statute .


