CONTRIBUTION AGREEMENT

This Agreement by and between Cadence Health, and Kane County Health Department of Aurora, Illinois ("**Grantee**"), is executed and effective this ____ day of _____, 2012.

Whereas, Cadence Health, as an integral part of its charitable mission, has a long history of promoting efforts to improve the safety and public health of the communities it serves;

Whereas, Grantee maintains one or more programs to provide opportunities for community outreach and education and enhancing public knowledge; and

Whereas, through discussion and cooperation, the parties to this Agreement have determined that the contribution outlined herein is an excellent means to further the charitable mission of Cadence Health while improving the safety and enhancing the health, community integrity, knowledge and overall well-being of the residents of Kane County and DuPage County, Illinois.

Now therefore, in furtherance of the goals and objectives outlined above, and in consideration of the contribution to Grantee as herein set forth, the parties agree as follows:

1. Upon Grantee's execution of this Agreement, Cadence Health agrees to contribute Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) (the "**Contribution Amount**") to Grantee in a lump sum to be applied toward the activities described on the attached and incorporated Exhibit A to this Agreement (the "**Community Program Description**").

2. Grantee further agrees to pursue diligently the development and implementation of the Community Program, and, will provide a written update with respect to its progress, and the use and application of the Contribution Amount by August 1, 2013. Grantee agrees to maintain financial and other business records that adequately demonstrate the use of the Contribution Amount exclusively for the purposes described in this Agreement.

3. Each party to this Agreement represents and warrants that it is duly authorized to enter into and perform this Agreement, and that the Agreement has been duly executed and delivered.

4. Grantee confirms that it is an Illinois not-for-profit corporation, exempt from federal income tax as an organization described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended (the "Code") and is not a private foundation within the meaning of Section 509(a)(1) of the Code.

5. All funds transferred to Grantee are transferred in trust to be used exclusively for purposes consistent with the charitable mission of Cadence Health, and as set forth in this Agreement. No portion of the Contribution Amount shall be used: (i) to make any attempt to influence legislation; (ii) to influence the outcome of any candidate for public office; (iii) to violate any law; or (iv) for the private benefit of any person.

6. In the event that Grantee is unable to develop and implement the Community Program, Grantee shall promptly notify Cadence Health, in which instance Grantee agrees that Cadence Health may direct Grantee to refund any unused portion of the Contribution Amount, or to transfer the unused portion of the Contribution Amount for another use consistent with Cadence Health's charitable mission.

7. Grantee acknowledges that (a) Grantee is solely responsible for the operation of the Program and for all uses of the Contribution Amount, including all activities and programs supported by the Contribution Amount; and, (b) Cadence Health is not a sponsor of or in any way responsible for the Community Program.

8. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of Cadence Health and Grantee with respect to the Contribution Amount and the Community Program, and may not be modified, waived or amended, in whole or in part, except by a writing signed by both parties. This Agreement shall be governed by, and construed and enforced in accordance with, the laws of the State of Illinois (without regard to its conflicts of law's provisions).

9. No provision of this Agreement shall be deemed or construed by the parties or any third person to create a joint venture or partnership among or between the parties, and there are no intended third party beneficiaries to this Agreement.

Exhibit A

Community Program Description

The Kane County TB Outbreak Implementation Plan will continue to focus on the identified tuberculosis outbreak. To date there are 42 active cases and 253 latent TB infection cases that have been linked from the outbreak. Additionally another 1154 individuals are in need of screening due to the potential exposure to an active, infectious individual. The Kane County TB Outbreak Implementation Plan will be utilizing best practices and strengthen impact in order to eliminate tuberculosis and maximize the extensive resources needed to control the current outbreak.

A report on the following measurable outcomes of the program will be submitted to Cadence Health by August 1, 2013:

The Kane County Health Department will evaluate the TB Outbreak Implementation Plan by measuring the number of latent cases treated to break the cycle of transmission, the number of active cases found early in the disease process, thus requiring less medical intervention, and the number of hospitalizations through aggressive active case findings. The Kane County has two epidemiologist will manage the outbreak data by utilizing the state surveillance system, INEDSS (Illinois National Electronic Disease Surveillance System) which will include surveillance/number of active cases, epidemiologically linked and or genotyped linked, surveillance/number of latent TB cases, completion of TB treatment rate, hospitalization rate and length of hospital stay rate, and infectious periods of cases.
