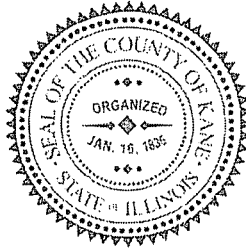



WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bidder for the Project is:


