## RESOLUTION NO. 10 - 156

## AUTHORIZING GRANT AGREEMENTS FOR RIVERBOAT GRANT FUNDING EXTERNAL PROJECTS AND FARMLAND PRESERVATION FOR 2010

WHEREAS, an agreement exists between the County of Kane and the Grand Victoria Casino that provides for the use of Riverboat Funds to assist in educational endeavors, environmental endeavors, and economic development endeavors; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Kane County Riverboat Grant Program is: To serve as a financial aid for programs strengthening Kane County's communities and government through efforts in education, environment, and economic development and with emphasis on addressing Kane County problems and providing long-term solutions; and

WHEREAS, numerous organizations submitted applications requesting monies from the Kane County Riverboat Grant Fund for projects that met the Guidelines, Policies and Procedures for the Kane County Riverboat Grant Program that were adopted by the Kane County Board in October, 2005 through Resolution 05-345; and

WHEREAS, the Kane County Riverboat Subcommittee carefully reviewed all the applications and recommended the attached list of organizations, projects, and dollar amounts to be funded through the 2010 Riverboat Grant funds; and

WHEREAS, additional County projects need to be funded; and

WHEREAS, the Kane County Riverboat Committee in the interest of creating approximately 2,170 temporary or full-time jobs and 7,800 man hours of employment desires to adjust the 2010 external grant allocation from the \$1,000,000 allocated under Resolution 09-431 and increase that allocation to \$2,165,000 for 2010 projects including \$500,000 for Farmland Preservation; and

WHEREAS, a budget adjustment needs to be made to the 2010 budget to reflect the additional grant allocation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Kane County Board that the Chairman of the Kane County Board is authorized to enter into a Grant Agreement with each of the named organizations for the project and dollar amount specified, and subject to the terms and conditions specified therein; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Kane County Board that the following fiscal year 2010 budget adjustment be made to reflect the additional grant allocation:
