

NOTICE OF FUND AVAILABILITY AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS
HUD 2012 CONTINUUM OF CARE HOMELESS APPLICATION PROCESS
KANE HOMELESS CONTINUUM

The Steering Committee is starting the application and selection process for HUD's 2012 Continuum of Care funding for the new bonus permanent housing project.

The amount of funds available is \$58,654 **over 1, 2 or 3 years** for one or more new Permanent Housing project. The Continuum may split the bonus amount between different agencies and projects.

The bonus project(s) may be any Permanent Housing project for homeless individuals/families with a disabling condition. There is a 20% case management limit on the total amount which is \$11,730. The remainder may be used for leasing, operations and up to 7% administration.

Please note however that HUD will still be expecting each CoC to increase their chronic homeless beds each year, so that should be a priority.

Projects may have NOT have mixed beds, i.e. some chronic, some regular permanent housing. A project may be either exclusively chronic or exclusively regular permanent housing.

Remember that all permanent housing projects are only for homeless persons with disabilities. Veterans are a HUD priority.

Agencies are encouraged to submit new projects for consideration by the Steering Committee at the October Continuum meeting for the upcoming HUD 2012 Continuum of Care application. These projects would include NEW Permanent Supportive Housing for homeless individuals/families with disabilities and NEW Permanent Supportive Housing for chronically homeless individuals/families.

Anyone interested in applying for the Bonus project should complete the esnaps Exhibit 2 which is also posted on this site. **Submissions are due at 5:00 pm, October 19, 2012, and should be emailed to ahamernik@hotmail.com.** The projects will be reviewed at the October Steering Committee meeting October 24, 2012, 1:00 p.m. at the Kane County Government Center; 719 S. Batavia Ave., Geneva, IL 60134, Building A, in the Auditorium and a selection will be made at that time.
