JUSTIFICATION OF POSITION:

Our felony caseloads are at unacceptably high levels and continue to increase. Of the current five felony courtrooms, only two of the rooms have the necessary three Assistant Public Defenders assigned. An additional two misdemeanor attorneys are needed in order to promote current attorneys to fill the needs of the felony courtrooms and caseloads.

It is the effect of the current existing mandates that we are to provide effective representation to indigent individuals accused of jailable offenses, under the Illinois Compiled Statutes, the Illinois Public Defender Act, the Illinois Counties Act, the Illinois and United States Constitutions, the Judiciary's Appointment power, and the Illinois Rules of Professional Conduct.

DEPARTMENTAL OBJECTIVES ADDRESSED BY FILLING THIS POSITION:
