Free* Recycling Event in St. Charles on Saturday 12/12/15 Electronics, Books, Liquid Latex Paint & Document Shredding

The Kane County Recycles Event on Saturday 12/12/15, between 8am and 12noon, will be held at 540 S Randall in St. Charles. Please do not arrive early. This event is for residents only – NO BUSINESSES! This will be the last event until April 9, 2016.

Recycle ELECTRONICS like computers, keyboards, laptops, printers, televisions (any size or age), stereos, cell phones, microwaves, Christmas lights, and more. We unload for you! We take BOOKS of any age and condition for reuse or recycling.

Liquid LATEX PAINT is the only item that has a recycling fee* per container, payable by the resident with cash or check. It is \$2 per pint, \$3.50 per gallon, and \$10 per 5-gallon bucket. Latex paint is non-toxic but difficult to dispose of normally because you have to dry it out before placing it in your landfill trash. However, it can be easily recycled into new products with no drying out necessary! No oil based product will be accepted.

Bring your confidential DOCUMENTS in paper bags or boxes. Limit is 4 boxes. This is for residents only. No documents from businesses please. More guidelines can be found at <http://www.countyofkane.org/recycling/pages/confidentialDocument.aspx>.

We do not accept hazardous waste or large household appliances like washers and refrigerators.
