



## **COVID-19 Community Event in Carpentersville Saturday**

**February 4, 2021** – The Kane County Health Department (KCHD) in collaboration with the Illinois Department of Public Health COVID-19 Equity Team and the State Mobile Testing Team present a COVID-19 Community Event on Saturday, February 6 from noon to 6 p.m. at La Alcancia Grocery Store, 651 Rt. 68 (Dundee Rd.) in Carpentersville.

The event offers free health screenings including HIV testing and blood pressure checks, NARCAN training and distribution, masks, PPE and other giveaways. Walk-up COVID-19 testing will also be available from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

A brief program will start at 1pm.
