CLERK CUNNINGHAM ANNOUNCES EXPANDED EARLY VOTING DATES AND LOCATIONS FOR JUNE 28 PRIMARY ELECTION

Kane County Clerk John A. Cunningham would like to announce that **expanded in-person Early Voting** for the **June 28 Primary Election** begins **Monday, June 13** and continues until Monday, June 27.

Clerk Cunningham said, “Beginning Monday, in-person Early Voting in Kane County will expand to 25 locations in Kane County. I am proud that our office offers the most Early Voting locations in the collar counties. **You can vote early at any Kane County Early Voting center, including our VoteMobile sites**, based on whatever is most convenient for you.”

Beginning **June 13**, the Clerk’s Office will have **7 Permanent Early Voting sites which are open 7 days a week** with varying hours. These sites include the **Kane County Clerk’s Office** locations in **Geneva**, 719 S. Batavia Ave. (Building B) and **Aurora**, 5 E. Downer Pl. (Suite F); **Fire Station No. 93**, 5000 Sleepy Hollow Rd., Carpentersville; **Elgin Township**, 729 S. McLean Blvd., Elgin; **Gail Borden Library**, 270 N. Grove Ave., Elgin; **Kane County Branch Court Conference Center**, 530 S. Randall Rd., St. Charles; and **Vaughn Athletic Center**, 2121 W. Indian Tr., Aurora.

18 additional Early Voting sites with varying hours will also be available throughout the county. **A complete list of all Early Voting sites is available at**

Cunningham added, “Having Early Voting locations throughout the county makes voting more convenient and accessible. Since we created our Voter Outreach Program in 2016, Early Voting has become even more popular with voters. If you plan to vote early, I encourage you to consider voting during the first week of expanded early voting, as we usually have the highest turnout in the last few days before Election Day.”
