**KANE COUNTY TO HOLD COMMUNITY INVESTMENT WORKSHOPS**

Kane County will kick-off the 2011 application cycle for its "Community Investment" programs by holding three workshops designed to provide information and assistance to potential applicants. Several Kane County programs will be highlighted, including the Riverboat Fund, Community Development Fund, Small-Cities Economic Development Program, and the Kane County Revolving Loan Fund for Energy Efficiency.

Kane County staff will be available at each workshop to provide an overview of the programs including qualifications, guidelines, the application process, and to answer questions. Additionally, representatives from the City of Elgin will attend the northern workshop, which is co-sponsored by the City and the County. City staff will discuss Elgin's Community Development Program, which is also accepting applications for 2011 funding. Workshop times and locations are as follows:
