Flu vaccine clinic added

The Kane County Health Department has scheduled an additional walk-in community flu shot clinic with no appointment needed. The clinic will be:

- 1 p.m. to 4 p.m., Tuesday, Jan. 2, 2007, at Senior Services Associates, Inc. 460 Garfield Ave. 2nd floor, Aurora.

Also, please remember the flu vaccine clinic scheduled from 2 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., Tuesday, Dec. 19, at the Fox River Chapter of the American Red Cross, 121 N. Second St., St. Charles.

The vaccination cost is \$20 cash, check, Illinois Public Aid Card or Medicare Card

Also, this is a great time for college students home for the holidays to get their flu vaccine. They could walk into the Kane County Health Dept. 1330 N. Highland Ave. in Aurora, Tuesday thru Friday, Dec. 26 through Dec. 29, from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. Again the fee is \$20 cash, check Illinois Public Aid Card or Medicare card, ages 19 or older. Influenza is not the gift you want to give or get this season. Get your flu shot, it's not too late.
