Contractor to trim trees along Fox River Trail, Jan. 11 - Feb. 19

GENEVA, IL — Tree trimming will take place along portions of the Fox River Trail in Elgin, South Elgin, and St. Charles, through Feb. 19.

Asplundh will remove any trees that are interfering with power lines. They'll also trim back other trees that are close to utility lines.

For the first project in Elgin, the work zone runs along the Fox River Trail from I-90 to Illinois Route 20. The next project's work zone in South Elgin will run along the Fox River Trail, from Stearns Road north to the Fox River bridge south. The final project's work zone will be along the Fox River bridge south to Villa Marie Road in St. Charles township.

No trail closures are expected, but there will be equipment present on the trail. The Forest Preserve District of Kane County asks trail users to use caution on the trail and to be mindful of the projects and heavy machinery being used. Signs for the project will be displayed to alert trail users.
