## “Local Farms = Fresh Foods = Better Health”

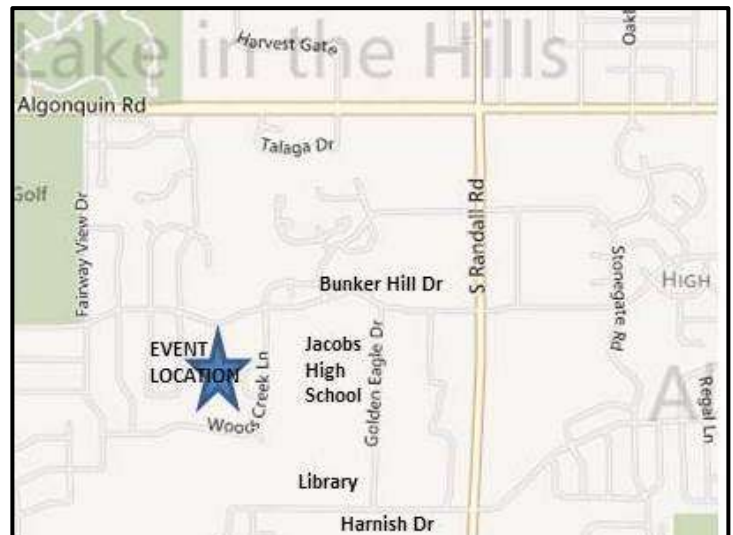
Friday, June 21 11:00am-2:00pm
