

NPDES Phase II

In 2003 municipalities, townships, and road commissions were required to submit a permit application or "Notice of Intent" to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System, Phase II regulations.

The IEPA then granted applicants a 5-year permit to operate their storm-water system. 2008 marks the end of our initial 5-year permits.

Have we accomplished what we set out to achieve under our original permits & plans? What do we need to do to continue our permits with IEPA? And what improvements or changes to our permits should we consider for the 2008-2011 permit cycle?
