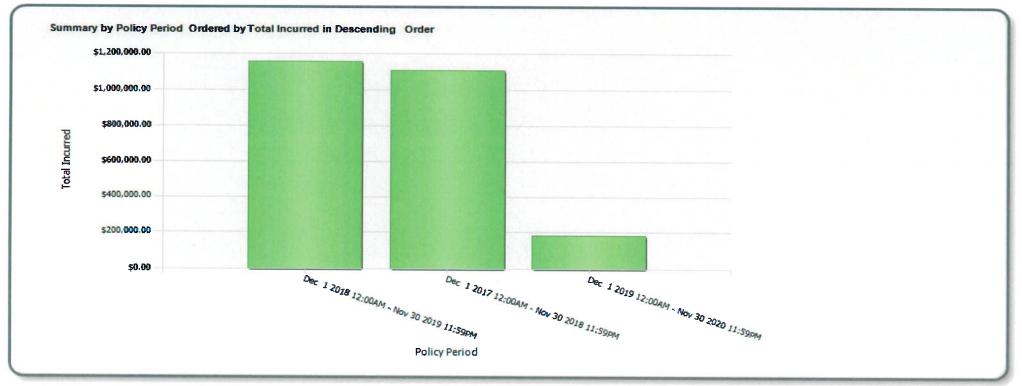

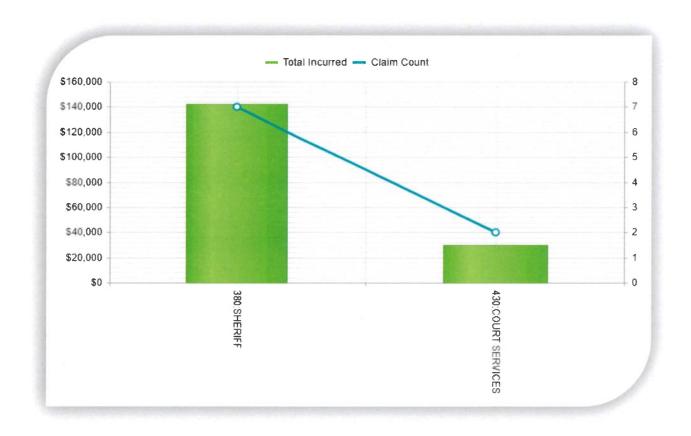

#### CANCELLING THE 2020 ANNUAL EMPLOYEE WELLNESS BIOMETRIC SCREENING DUE TO COVID-19

WHEREAS, due to the public health emergency associated with the global COVID-19 pandemic, it is necessary to minimize employees' potential exposure to COVID-19 by cancelling large-scale events and reducing occupancy levels within County buildings; and

WHEREAS, the County offers an annual employee wellness biometric screening event in connection with its group health plan; and

WHEREAS, Open Enrollment will be from October 1 to 30, 2020, and employees will be able to elect or change benefits remotely from the Alight Benefit Administration System; and

All eligible employees and their spouses will be deemed to have participated in the County's Wellness Program for purposes of calculating the employees' insurance premiums for the 2021 plan year.
