

Special Recycling Event in Aurora

Saturday, December 4th, 2021; 8am – 12pm



Location: 911 N Lake St., Aurora (down driveway on east side of road, across from Northgate Shopping Center)

Costs: All items are FREE to drop off (except for TVs, Monitors, aerosol products, and propane cans*).

Items Accepted:

- **Electronics:** TVs*, Computers, Monitors*, Laptops, Phones, Cords, Cables, Servers, Printers, Scanners, Keyboards, Stereos, Speakers, Battery backups, Gaming consoles, Power tools, Holiday lights, and more. **There is a cost to recycle TVs and monitors, payable by the resident with cash or card – \$25 fee for screens under 21 inches (measured diagonally) & \$35 fee for screens 21 inches or over.*
- **Books:** Hard cover or paperback books of any age, in any condition, for reuse or recycling.
- **Clothing & Shoes:** Clothing items of any kind. Paired shoes of any kind. Accessories, like hats, purses, belts, scarves. Textiles, like sheets, towels, curtains, blankets. These items can be in any condition, even if worn or torn, as long as they are clean. All will be reused or recycled.
- **Appliances:** Household appliances, like washers, dryers, toasters, blenders, vacuums. We do not take freon-containing devices like refrigerators or air-conditioners.
- **Scrap Metal:** Anything made of metal, like lawn furniture, BBQs, fire pits, pots and pans, hot water tanks, hardware, metal fencing, bed frames, etc.
- **Paper:** Magazines, periodicals, brochures, office paper, newspaper, packing paper.
- **Cardboard:** Corrugated cardboard (flattened).
- **Shredded Paper:** Shredded paper (in paper bags, stapled shut).
- **Aerosol Products*:** Spray paint, sealer, stains, rust control, insecticide, repellent, pesticide, household cleaners, polishes, disinfectants, protectants, personal care products, for hair, face, and skin, cooking spray, food products, whipped cream, auto lubricant, starter fluid, tar remover, brake cleaner, and inhalers. **There's a cost to recycle these, payable by the resident with cash or card - \$1 per can.*
- **Propane Canisters*:** only the small camp-sized cans are accepted here (14.1 oz - 16.4 oz). **There is a cost to recycle these products, payable by the resident with cash or card -\$3.50 per canister.*

Regular Hours: This location is open year-round Monday through Friday from 8am to 4pm, so you can visit any weekday. This special one-day event offers the opportunity to recycle on a weekend.

Partners: Kane County and, eWorks Electronics Services, are partnering with Vet Tech US for this special event and for the ongoing services at this location.
