For Hard-to Recycle Materials

- **Aerosol Products & Small Fuel Canisters:** Full or empty spray cans will be accepted, as will small (16 oz. or smaller) propane and isobutane tanks. See list of accepted materials [here](#). **Cost***
- **Batteries:** All dry cell types (alkaline, button cell, rechargeable). Please separate any lithium/lithium ion batteries.
- **Bikes, helmets, bike baskets:** (Adult and children's bikes in repairable condition, no rusty bikes or parts)
- **Books:** text books, children's books, paperback and hardcover books in good condition for reuse, obsolete and damaged books and catalogues for recycling. See details [here](#).
- **Clothing, wearable accessories & household textiles:** Clean, dry and free of odors but does not need to be in wearable condition. Remove all hangers. See full list of accepted items [here](#).
- **Corrugated cardboard:** Please flatten boxes.
- **Electronics & holiday lights:** computers, TVs*, DVD/Blu-Ray players, printers, copiers, keyboards, mice, computer monitors*, cables, receivers, tablets, phones, video game systems & more. Full list can be found [here](#). **Cost***
- **Fluorescent Lamps:** 4-foot tubes and CFL bulbs from residential sources only.
- **Latex Paint:** Liquid water-based paint and primer only. Cans should not be combined. See details [here](#). **Cost***
- **Shredded paper:** You can bring already-shredded paper in paper bags stapled shut to the books recycling area. We will not be shredding on site at this event.
- **Styrofoam blocks and food service foam:** Please bring clean, sorted materials.

*Costs (all fees payable by cash or card at the event - all items with no fee noted are free to bring)

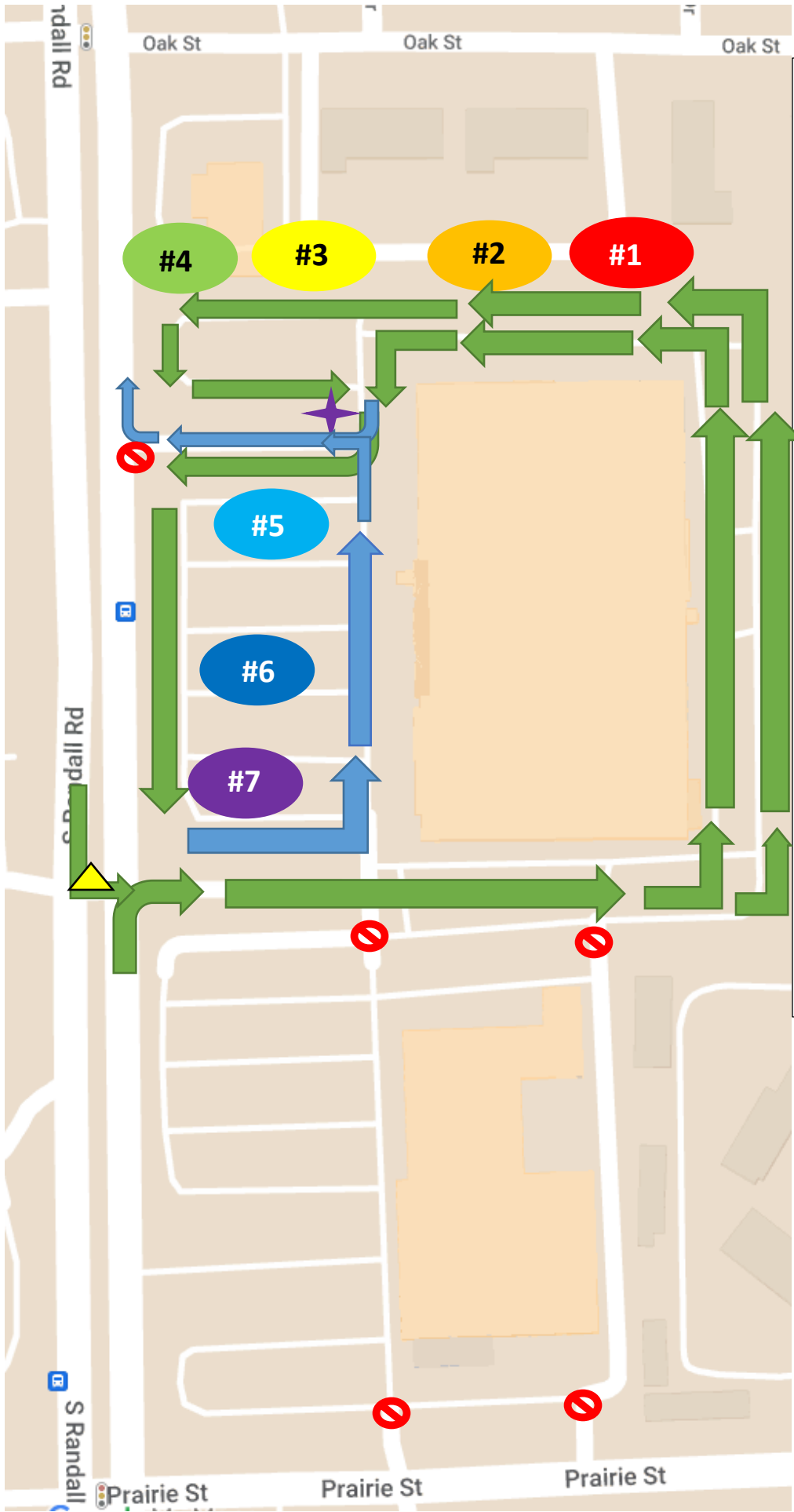
- **Aerosol Cans & Fuel Canisters:** \$1 per aerosol item and isobutane canisters, \$3 per small propane canister
- **TVs and Monitors:** \$25 for screens under 21" measured diagonally; \$35 for 21" and over
- **Latex Paint Cans:** \$1 per pint can, \$3 per gallon can, \$5 per 2 gallon can, \$15 per 5 gallon bucket

We will NOT be collecting:






- **NO Confidential Document Shredding** at this event! Our next shred event is August 13th.
- **NO Oil-based paint** Free drop off at the Naperville HHW facility, more info [here](#).
- **NO Lead-acid batteries** Free drop off at the Naperville HHW facility, more info [here](#).
- **Misc. non-accepted items include:** carpet, furniture, home décor, toys, household hazardous waste, tires, bubble wrap, packing peanuts, mobility devices, sewing machines, large appliances, incandescent and halogen lightbulbs.
- **No business-generated materials; residential only. Thank you!**






