## ALTERNATIVE DROP-OFFS FOR UNACCEPTED MATERIALS:

In order to keep costs down and serve as many residents as possible within budget, the following items are not accepted through this collection program because there are options in the community for recycling. Please drop these items off as directed below. Thank you.

### Batteries

- Household batteries (AAA, AA, C, D, 6-volt, 9-volt, and nickel-cadmium rechargeable) may be dropped off for recycling Monday - Friday (excluding holidays) from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the Batavia Public Works Facility, 200 N Raddant Road. Please go to the office entrance on west side of building and deposit batteries in the appropriate container in the vestibule area. Hearing aid, watch, and car batteries are not accepted at Public Works.
- Auto batteries: 3 local service stations:
  - Batavia Citgo, 27 N Batavia Avenue (no charge)
  - Batavia Firestone, 351 S Randall Road (no charge)
  - Park & Sons Auto Repair, 403 E Wilson Street (no charge)

### Motor Oil

- 3 local service stations:
  - Batavia Citgo, 27 N Batavia Avenue (\$1/gallon)
  - Batavia Firestone, 351 S Randall Road (no charge)
  - Park & Sons Auto Repair, 403 E Wilson Street (no charge)

### Paint

- Cans from latex paint can go in regular trash once paint is solidified (dry out with kitty litter or absorbent) or dropped off at a Kane County Recycling Event (fee applies). See [www.countyofkane.org/recycling/pages/paint.aspx](http://www.countyofkane.org/recycling/pages/paint.aspx)

### Pharmaceuticals/Medications

- The Batavia Police Department has provided a steel mailbox-style collection box in the front lobby of the City Hall, which citizens may use to deposit their unwanted or expired medications. The collection box is clearly marked for this purpose, locked and under 24 hour surveillance. Citizens may place their unused or expired medications into the collection box anonymously.
