



### **Process Engineer II**

### **Maintenance Mechanic – 3/2 (12-Hour Night Shift)**

Set-up and operator a wide variety of conventional lathes, mills, presses and other machine shop equipment to fabricate or repair parts for operations. Utilizes precision measuring instruments, such as micrometers and calipers to check tolerances and to insure the finished product meets the specification called out in sketches, blueprints, work orders or samples. Analyzes lays-out and plans jobs including obtaining diagrams, tools, spare parts and supplies. Welding tasks include TIG, MIG, stick and brazing. Perform repairs to hydraulic and pneumatic systems. Minimum 5 years manufacturing machinist experience.

### **Material Handler – 2<sup>nd</sup> Shift**

Efficient operation of stand-up and sit-down fork lift to move materials; Performance of routine safety inspections and of fork lift equipment; Loading and unloading semi-trucks; Moving material, general support of warehouse, shipping/receiving, and material handling functions. General understanding of rack numbering systems, tags, raw materials and WIP.

### **Press Operator – 3/2 (12-Hour Night Shift)**

Set-up and run rotogravure printing press. Monitor equipment and the production process to ensure quality. Demonstrate timely and effective problem-solving skills and have a solid working knowledge of the raw materials and films used, effective interaction skills to support team activities related to effective process decisions and goals. Demonstrate knowledge of plant and process safety rules, safe operating methods and good housekeeping standards. Enter/retrieve data into computer. Monitor inks/adhesives.

### **Laminator Operator – 2<sup>nd</sup> Shift**

The Laminator Operator is responsible for the overall operation of the Laminator, which includes, but is not limited to: Set-up and monitor the machine process to assure quality product. Ensure productivity goals are met for department/machine by monitoring run speeds, set up times and coordination of support departments. Troubleshoot and correct problems. Communication orally and/or in writing to other departments for resolution of mechanical problems, reporting defective material, coordination of job preparations, change overs and daily shift information. Accurate and timely production reporting. Training new associates. Comply with all safety rules
